NOTES

1. You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying the Society.
2. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the Society reclaims on your donation in the tax year (currently 28p for each £1 you give).
3. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax the Society reclaims, you can cancel your declaration (see note 1).
4. If you pay at the higher tax rate you can claim for higher tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
5. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask the Society or ask your local tax office.
